You can choose to sign into the Chrome browser if that's what you used to create this gmail account. This isn't necessary if you don't want to.



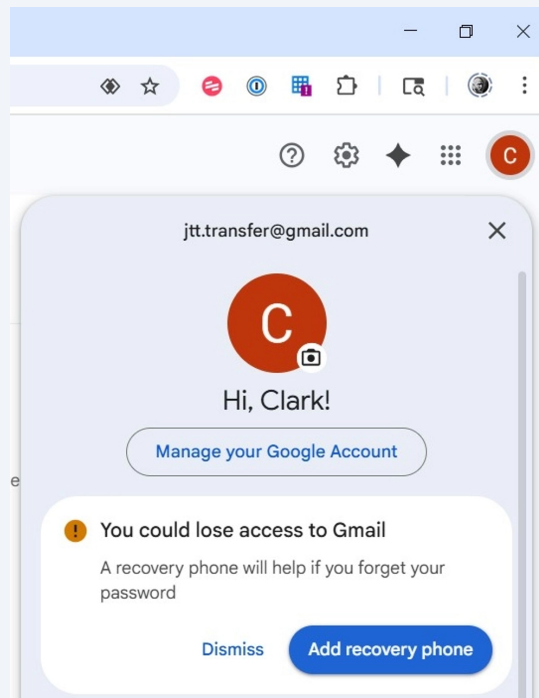
